



## Toilet Roll Dogs

These are definitely my favourite toilet roll animal so far. We searched for dog silhouettes on the internet, so you can make different breeds of dogs if you wish. Or just use our templates on the next page.

### Equipment

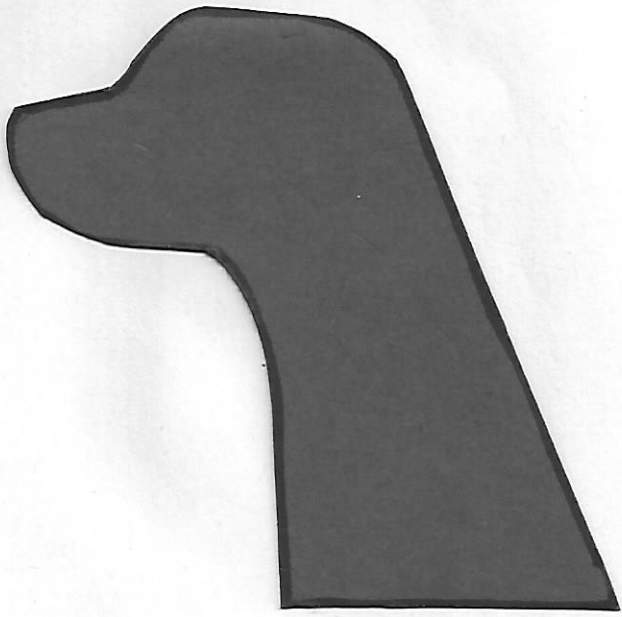
Cardboard tubes  
 Medium thickness card (too thin and the legs collapse)  
 Glue or stapler  
 Split pins  
 Paint and Sharpies  
 Scissors

### Method

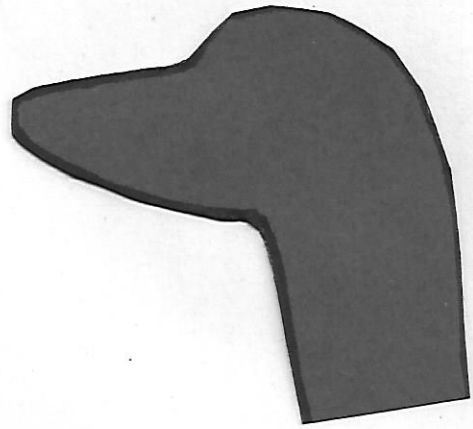
1. Fold the card in half and draw around the dog-head template so that the top of the head is on the crease.
2. Draw around the leg and tail templates. Cut them all out.
3. Paint the cut-out pieces and a cardboard tube and leave to dry.
4. Once the paint is dry, either glue or staple the head onto the cardboard tube.
5. Poke a hole in the top of the each of the leg pieces and in the sides of the cardboard tube. (Younger children might need help with this step.) Push a split pin through the hole in the top of each leg and the side of the tube to connect the legs to the body.
6. Cut a small slit in the back edge of the tube. Cut another small slit in the tail and attach to the body.
7. Finally, draw eyes, nose and ears onto your dog, and it's finished.

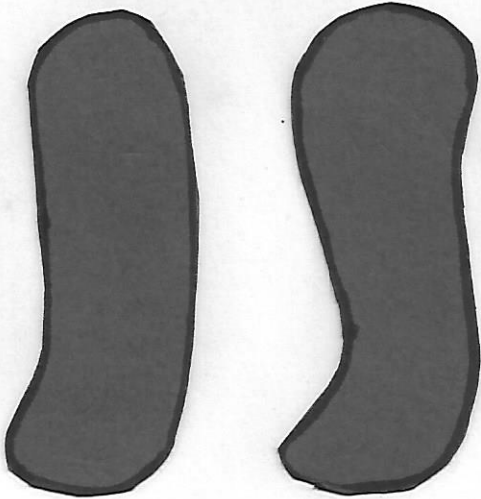
